Council Note on the Education Year: The Council has approved two proposals from the Executive Committee regarding return to our educational programs. The approach we are taking considers the need to return to our activities while also balancing the Covid risk with safety measures. The Executive Committee will continue to monitor infection rates in our community and any new government recommendations/mandates that may change our plans to have these Educational programs in place. These decisions developed after discussions and research of how other organizations are handling similar situations. We ask for your prayers, patience, and understanding as we navigate this challenging situation. Please do not hesitate to contact any member of the Executive Committee with questions, comments, or concerns.

Sunday Education: All Sunday Education programs will begin, indoors, on Sept. 20. It is recommended, but not required, that everyone wear masks in all indoor Fellowship areas and when at risk of not being able to social distance. Once in the classrooms, students and teachers would not be required to wear masks. Social distancing in the classrooms will be done as much as possible, but due to the size of the classrooms and the number of students the 6 feet spacing most likely will not be able to consistently be maintained.

Family Night: All Wednesday night programs will begin, indoors, on October 7. The mealtime will be simplified, tables and chairs will be spaced out, and it is recommended that people only sit with those that they are already interacting with regularly. It is recommended, but not required, that everyone wear masks in all indoor Fellowship areas and when at risk of not being able to social distance. The program leaders will work with the Executive team to make adjustments to reduce the risk of Covid exposure.

Safety Protocol for other groups and activities:

1. Starting the week of June 21, gatherings of any size are allowed at church as long as social distancing guidelines can be followed.
2. Gatherings of large groups are recommended to be outside whenever possible.
3. If it is necessary to meet indoors please follow social distancing guidelines and it is recommended to wear a mask when interacting with others.
